SYNOPSIS

DIRECTOR'S BIOGRAPHY

Philippe Lesage began his career as a documentary filmmaker, directing four noted features, including THE HEART THAT BEATS (2010), which won several awards, notably Québec's Jutra for Best Feature Documentary (2012).

His debut fiction feature, THE DEMON (2015), premiered in official competition in San Sebastian and has been invited to more than 60 international festivals. THE DEMONS won the San Francisco Golden Gate Award, was included in the TIFF Top Ten, and was named one of the top ten films of 2015 by Variety.

DIRECTOR'S STATEMENT

My background as a documentary filmmaker plunged me into different worlds (the Parisian suburbs, a Montreal hospital, teenagers in the countryside). Fiction brought me back to introspection.

With GENESIS I deepen the autobiographical approach I began with COPENHAGEN A LOVE STORY and THE DEMONS. Whereas THE DEMONS deals with my childhood, **GENESIS** portays my teenage years. My cinema is always about a quest for truth and authenticity.

I want to spurn convention: to make documentaries that echo fiction and fiction that borrows from documentary. Using your own life as the raw material for making a film is risky. Holding up a mirror in front of you risks inhibiting you from seeing beyond yourself. I don't seek to "express myself"; instead I seek, when it all comes together, to express the world.

Starting with my experience, certainly, but to better portray what we all experience, where we all come from.

GENESIS is about the birth of desire for love, our need to love, to be loved, the power of desire, and about how society intervenes, monitors, even punishes our passionate impulses. My characters demand the right to live, to love, and to dream passionately. They are too young to protect themselves, to retreat, to give up. In the end, the beauty of youth is that it can never disappoint: it's the future.
